A non-mandatory, but recommended, pre-qualification conference was held on Tuesday, September 12, 2017, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm at the Medina County Solid Waste District Facility (MCSWDF), 8700 Lake Road, Seville, Ohio, 44273. All attendees were asked to sign in on the "sign in" sheet to demonstrate their attendance. A copy of the "sign in" sheet is attached to this Addendum 1.

The meeting discussion consisted of introductions, followed by a general review of the Request for Qualification (RFQ) document, with several opportunities given to the attendees to ask questions relative to the RFQ.

Notice was given for potential Responders to register their interest in the RFQ with the Project Coordinator, Laura Perkins, to ensure that they receive clarifications or revisions to the RFQ. Attendees were reminded of the second opportunity to visit the MCSWDF to obtain additional measurements on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm, with reservations required. Unscheduled visits to the MCSWDF are prohibited.

During the meeting, attendees were provided with a listing of the Medina County Solid Waste District (District) Contracts to demonstrate the current contracts and terms per the Sum of All Parts (SOAP) strategy as outlined in the District's Ohio EPA approved Solid Waste Management Plan Update. A copy of the District's handout is attached hereto to Addendum 1.

A full size orthophotograph of the MCSWDF was previewed, and subsequently made available to attendees for further review. With the issuance of this Addendum 1, a link to the orthophotograph has been posted to the Medina County Official Bid Notice website.

Following the discussion session, attendees were given access to record drawings of the MCSWDF, referenced as year 1993 Drawings and year 2001 Improvement Plans. With the issuance of this Addendum 1, links to the above referenced PDF drawings have similarly been posted to the Medina County Official Bid Notice website.

Attendees were encouraged to become familiar with the MCSWDF buildings and grounds following the business portion of the conference and to comply with the District's visitor requirements. Personal protective equipment (PPE), and visitors badges were returned to District administration as attendees concluded their self-guided property visit.

Questions posed by the attendees during the conference are listed below, along with the respective answer in a Q/A format:

1. Question - Part II listed in the RFQ weighs in on responses for the qualifications preparation. Is there any way that potential Respondents can get those detailed materials earlier, or could the RFQ response date be revised to coincide with the issuance of the detailed Part II?

Answer - Potential Respondents that have registered their interest in the RFQ will be provided the latest information as it becomes available. The sequence of events and schedule remains as detailed in the RFQ, with the request for Part II Project Proposals, and final description of the project available on October 24, 2017.

2. Question - Can the responses to the RFQ be kept confidential? Generally speaking, ideas disclosed during Part I can then be used by others for Part II.

Answer - Respondents are referred to Form A-6C of the RFQ titled "Designation of Confidential and Proprietary Information" regarding designation of what they consider proprietary and confidential information included in their RFQ response.

3. Question - Is it correct that the main reason for the RFQ process is to exclude pricing? And that pricing will not be required until the Part II Project Proposal phase?

Answer – Correct, Respondents shall not submit a pricing proposal unless requested to do so in accordance with the Part II Project Proposal phase.

4. Question - Is all of the property subject to RFQ utilization?

Answer - With the exception of the stand-alone building on the south side of the existing District scale house, referred to as "8730" based on the street address, and the Class IV yard waste area, the balance of the property may be considered by the Respondents. In addition, the District will retain the administrative area as is currently utilized on the second floor, and as referenced in the RFQ.

Referenced in the RFQ is the recent completion of a desktop Waste Characterization as performed by RRS for the District. With the issuance of this Addendum 1, a link to the Waste Characterization has been posted to the Medina County Official Bid Notice website.

The equipment located within the former processing area of the MCSWDF has been idle since January 11, 2015. The District has issued an Invitation to Bid for the Right to Purchase or Salvage, and Remove the Recycling/Salvage Equipment from the MCSWDF. The Salvages Services Bid was issued on September 7, 2017, with additional information available at the Medina County Official Bid Notice website: <http://www.co.medina.oh.us/legal.htm>. Unless changed by Addenda or Contract specific to the Salvages Services Bid opportunity, all work, inclusive of equipment and material removal and clean-up, shall be completed by December 1, 2017.
